

## Goat Hill Designs – Instructional Classes

Gail Dufresne invites you to join her for 2 exciting classes she will be teaching onboard the Anthem of the Seas.

### Friday, October 11: Funky Fish

This piece incorporates many different fibers and techniques. Fibers used are velvet, wool, sparkle wool, various sari silk yarns, novelty fabric, novelty yarns, and roving. Techniques to be discussed are shearing, needle felting, cording, standing wool circles, and how to finish an uneven edge. Cuts used are #3 through #9. We will talk about how to hook with or otherwise use all of these materials as well as how and when to apply all of these techniques. All materials necessary to finish the project as well as a design on linen will be provided. Size is 19” at the widest edge and 8” at the narrowest. You will be able to select your own materials for color plans that differ from mine. Feel free to bring along materials you have that you would like to incorporate or materials that you would like to talk about as to how they can be used.



Cost: \$115. Please note that one of the three funky fish in the photo is on a tote bag. This bag is NOT included in the cost but can be purchased separately.

### Wednesday, October 16: Mixed Media Sunflower

Explore the use of fabrics other than wool, such as but not limited to, sari silk, yarns, found objects.....the sky is the limit! Techniques such as standing wool circles, beading, sculpting, trapunto, and prodding will be demonstrated. Students will explore how to use these materials to create an unusual finished piece. Design is 10” by 14”. There will be a selection of materials so everyone can have a unique piece. Feel free to bring along materials you would like to incorporate.



Course includes a design and materials to complete the piece for \$115.

**Friday, October 18:** informal lecture and help with kits from the past two free days when needed. We can discuss anything you like! Dyeing, mixed media fibers and techniques, ge metrics, other. I will also be happy to help you make decisions about any projects you have brought with you. There will be wool and other supplies for sale at our meeting room!
